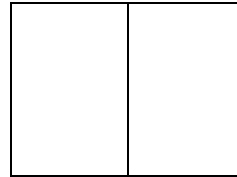


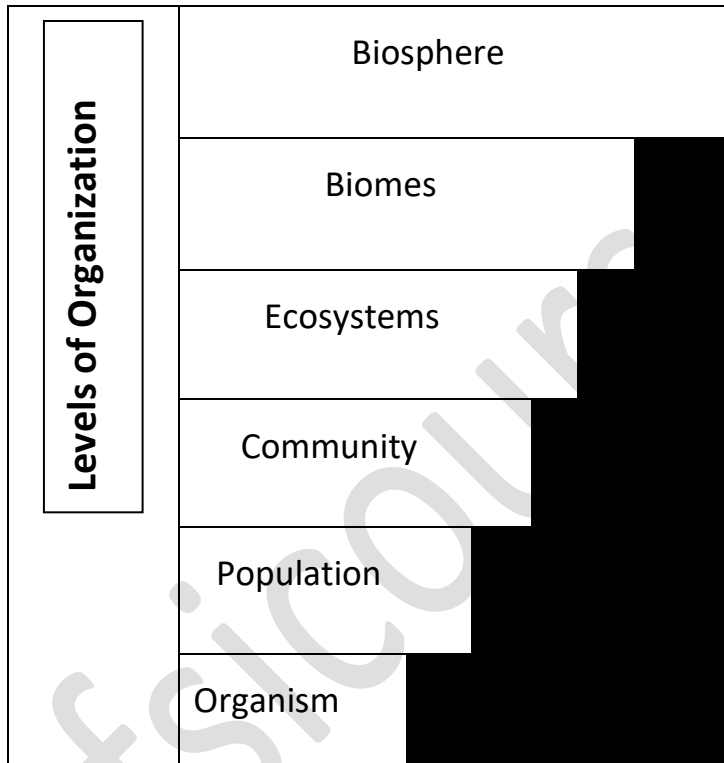
Learning Target: I can describe and explain the biological levels of organization.

Biological Levels of Organization Foldable

1. Turn your paper the long way (hotdog style). Fold your paper in half. You should now have a line down the middle of your paper. It should now look like this:



2. Open up your foldable and cut 5 lines, with each line being about 1.5 inches on the right side of your paper which will give you 6 flaps on the right. Cut off where you see the black parts. Make sure not to cut all the way to the edge! You will write 'Levels of organization' on the left as shown in the example below. It should look like this now. Label with the words you see on the foldable below.



4. Open up each flap and write the definition of each term behind the flap on the left-hand side.

5. Open up each flap and draw a picture representing the term on the right-hand side.
